
The activities performed by the Examination Cell during 2021-22 are summarized as follows. This information relates to the overall performance of the Examination Cell for F.Y., S.Y., T.Y. B.Com/B.A., M.Com, M.A Part I, Part II and Degree with Honours Program examinations.

The Regular and Backlog Examinations of Semester 1,3 and 5, and Backlog examinations of semester 2,4 and 6 of UG were held between 23rd November 2021 to 24th December 2021. Regular semester 3 and Backlog of of semester 1,2,4 of PG were held between 13th January 2022 to 22nd January 2022 and regular examination of sem 1 PG were held between 22nd February 2022 to 4th March 2022. Open Book Examination pattern was used for these exams and exams were conducted using Google classrooms. On average results were declared in 30days.

The process followed for conducting examinations using Google classroom is as follows:








The regular semester end and backlog examinations of Semester 2,4 and 6 and Backlog examinations of Semester 1,3 and 5 of UG were conducted between 12th April 2022 to 18th May 2022. Regular examination of Semester 4 along with and Backlog examinations of Semester 1,2,3 and 4 of PG were conducted between 26th May 2022 to 3rd June 2022. Regular Semester 2 along with Semester 1 backlog for PG were conducted between 28th June 2022 to 2nd July 2022. These all examinations were conducted offline in the college campus. On average results were declared in 23 days.
