# POST GRADUATE STUDENTS

MODE OF APPLYING:- The scheme is implemented through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It is mandatory for all students to apply online on the **website i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in.** 

Before filling the application form you have to check the eligibility criteria, guidelines, FAQ's and required documents of the said scheme and submit the hardcopy alongwith necessary documents to the Scholarship Section.

- 1) Print out of scholarship application form duly signed by student.
- 2) Income Certificate, issued from a Competent Authority in respect of parent/guardian of the student. (F.Y. 2023-2024)
- 3) A Self-Certified Community Certificate (if Applicable)
- 4) Domicile Certificate/Permanent Resident Certificate.
- 5) Bonafide Student Certificate.
- 6) Students Bank Account Details
- 7) Aadhar card
- 8) Fee Receipt- 2024-25

#### **ELIGIBILITY: -**

Slots: 3000

**Age limit**: Girl students up to the age of 30 years at the time of admission in first year of PG courses are eligible.

The scheme is applicable to such single girl child who has taken admission in regular, full-time first year Master's Degree course in any designated university or a post graduate college.

Admission to PG Course in Distance education mode is not covered under the scheme.

## **DISTRIBUTION: -**

- a) To support post graduate education of single girl child in postgraduate courses only.
- b) To recognize the value of observance of small family norm.

## CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- a) Girl students who are admitted in the first year of PG courses in the following Universities / Colleges and happen to be the only girl child in the family:
- b) Universities/Institutions/Colleges included under section 2(f) & and 12(B) of UGC Act.
- c) Deemed to be Universities included under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 and eligible to receive grants-in-aid from UGC. Those Deemed Universities which do not receive funds from the Central/ State Government are not eligible institutions under the scheme.
- d) Universities/Institutions/College funded by Central/State Government.
- e) Institutes of National Importance.
- f) Girl students without having any brother or the girl student who are twin daughters/ fraternal daughter may also apply for scholarship under the aforesaid scheme. In a family if one son and one daughter is available then girl child will not be considered for scholarship under the scheme.

(18) The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India vide its letter D.O. No. 18- 7/2013-U1A dated 10th June, 2016 has instructed the University Grants Commission that from the financial year 2016-17 onwards the Aadhaar will be used as an identifier for disbursement of all Government subsidies/Scholarships/Fellowships which are to be disbursed directly into the beneficiary's account. The disbursals will be governed by the Aadhaar Act, 2016.
